

COVID-19 Statement

The health and safety of our patients, providers and staff remain our number one concern. We are vigilantly monitoring the dynamic COVID-19 recommendations and mandates from the CDC. At this time, Swank Chiropractic Sports Medicine is open to see patients. It is well established that the second most common reason that people seek medical attention is back pain, along with bone and joint disorders. As part of the healthcare system, we will continue to provide our services to this portion of the population. This continuation of care helps to decrease the burden on our medical colleagues and allows them to remain focused on treating the more serious and imminent health issues related to COVID-19.

We continue to keep our office as clean and safe as possible. As always, we continue to follow our standard protocols to maintain a clean, sanitary environment for our patients. However, in response to the pandemic, we have implemented higher than usual sanitation practices. We are regularly sanitizing and disinfecting common areas, doors and door handles, common areas and front desk work spaces, including all patient folders and common touch points. Similarly, consistent with our standard practices, our treatment rooms including tables and chairs are being disinfected after each patient visit with alcohol-based products.

In addition to implementing the CDC Guidelines for Outpatient Care Centers, we are also implementing the following:

1. We are scheduling patient appointments in a manner to decrease the number of patients in our office at any one time.
2. During your Swank Chiropractic Sports Medicine visit, we ask that you, as possible, maintain a responsible distance between you, other patients and staff.
3. We ask that patients limit the number of individuals that accompany them to their appointments.
4. Symptomatic patients will be asked to return home and reschedule.

If you are well and have a scheduled appointment, we are here to serve you, while at the same time provide a safe and sanitary environment to do so. However, if you are feeling ill or have concerns that you have been exposed to the virus, we ask that you reschedule your appointment.

The situation continues to evolve quickly and we are monitoring it closely. We continue to refer to the CDC, the World Health Organization, and other public health agencies to determine the safest course of action for our patients. We also comply with all federal and state government mandates.
